

The Aberdeen Hub Area Habitat for Humanity Inc. is a locally controlled organization serving people in the Aberdeen area. It was incorporated in 1993 as an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International.

90% of donated money is used to build homes and operate the affiliate. Mortgage income is used to build homes.

The Hub Area Habitat for Humanity affiliate tithes 10% of our donated income to Habitat for Humanity International. These funds are used to build homes outside of the USA.

The Aberdeen Hub Area Habitat for Humanity may have an AmerCorps member who assists in the operating of the organization.

Developing communities by building and renovating simple affordable houses.

Habitat for Humanity is an ecumenical Christian non-profit organization that relies on the gifts of its supporters to build simple, decent, safe and affordable houses on terms families can afford to pay.

Here's how it works: Every Habitat house built anywhere in the world is paid for in two ways: first through hundreds of hours of "sweat equity" by the selected homeowner family, and second, through their monthly mortgage payments.

Habitat builds modest sized houses. The monthly, no-profit, no-interest mortgage payment is low. House payments revert back to a Fund for Humanity so additional houses can be built.

Applications are considered on the basis of need, ability to repay and willingness to partner with the local Habitat affiliate. Habitat does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, or marital status.

Three Philosophies of Habitat for Humanity

1. Theology of the Hammer
We must put faith and love into action.



2. Economics of Jesus
Habitat charges no interest and makes no profit on the sale of Habitat homes.



3. Love in the Mortar Joints
All relationships are equally important to the actual building of houses-partner families, volunteers, donors and all parties in the building partnership.
